

Greenstone Interface Customization using Apache Web Server

- 1) Design your DL home page and save it in the document directory of your web server (*htdocs* folder in Apache Server and *wwwroot* in IIS). Hyperlink your collections in your customized page.

Advantage: As you are hosting the page out side greenstone directory, you can very well use flash, stylesheet, javascript etc. for designing your page.

- 2) Redirect greenstone home button to use your new page as DL home page which is saved in the web server document directory.

Steps:

- i) Edit the file **nav_css.dm** in **macros** folder in greenstone directory and find

```
_homelink_ { _navtaborig_( _httppagehome_, _linktextHOME_, _textdescrhome_ ) }  
in package Global section.
```

- ii) Change it as:

```
#_homelink_ { _navtaborig_( _httppagehome_, _linktextHOME_, _textdescrhome_ ) }  
_homelink_ { _navtaborig_( http://yourlibrary.com, _linktextHOME_, _textdescrhome_ ) }
```

where *yourlibrary.com* is your home page link.

Redirecting the home page button of a particular collection

Give the following string in your collection specific macro file ie, **extra.dm** which is in macros folder

```
package Global  
_homelink_ { _navtaborig_( http://172.20.1.78/library, _linktextHOME_, _textdescrhome_ ) }
```

Where **http://172.20.1.78/library** is the home page link

- 3) Restart greenstone server for applying the changes.
