About The College: -

This is one of the premier institute of commerce education and a provincialised colleges of Assam, situated at the headquarter of Tinsukia district. The college was established in the year 1972 for Higher Secondary and Degree courses of commerce, but, in the year 2011 degree Arts has also been started. Moreover, the college provides opportunity for the open and distance learners through the study centers of K.K.H.S.O. University and Distance education under Dibrugarh University. The exact location of the college is at 700 No. gate, Sripuria, which is about 2 KM away from Tinikoniya Pukhuri stoppage of NH 37.

Connectivity:-

Tinsukia is well connected by Air, Road and Rail. It is only 492 km by road from Guwahati. The nearest airport is Dibrugarh Airport at Mohanbari, Dibrugarh which is about 40 km away from Tinsukia with daily connectivity to Delhi, Guwahati and Kolkata. Tinsukia town is very well connected by railway. A number of trains either starts from Tinsukia or run through Tinsukia station to different parts of the country. Tinsukia has got two nearby stations and both are about 3 KMs. away from the college. Tinsukia has got well organised day & night bus services which are run through Tinsukia to different parts of the state. ASTC bus stand is 4 KM away from the college. Local transportation is facilitated by Auto Rickshaws, Magic Trackers, and Rickshaws.

Climate of Tinsukia: -

Tinsukia experiences a humid subtropical climate. The Climate of Tinsukia during September means “Hot days are gone and Cold days are waiting to welcome. So, we can expect a pleasant weather during workshop Days.

A number of workshops have already been conducted in different times and in deferent places of the county but, North Eastern Region is still lagging behind.
